Crusader Academic Performance (CAP) Scores

GPA is important but should not be the only significant factor in determining our Top Ten students. Muskegon Catholic Central seeks to honor those students that have demonstrated academic excellence in terms of class performance, test scores, and a challenging curriculum.

Our Top Ten students are selected using a formula that weights:

- GPA at 50%
- Assessments results at 15%
- Advanced courses at 35%.

Scores also include:

- Explore Test results for Freshmen
- PLAN Test results for Sophomore
- Michigan Merit Exam results for Juniors
- ACT results for Seniors

Assessment results are not cumulative and are only calculated to demonstrate a students' performance within each academic year.

Honors points and GPA are calculated at all grade levels and are cumulative.

The formula that includes GPA, ACT, and advanced courses identifies the Top Ten students of the senior class and is used to select the valedictorian and salutatorian.
