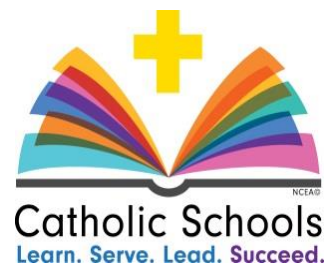

Catholic Schools Week Service Project

This year Muskegon Catholic Central will partner with *Kids' Food Basket* in Muskegon County.
What is Kids Food Basket?

Kids' Food Basket is a nonprofit organization attacking childhood hunger to help young people learn and live well. They serve nearly 7,500 kids each weekday in West Michigan through their sack suppers, 1150 of these children in Muskegon County alone. Sack Suppers are evening meals that are well-rounded and nutritious.

Details of our Service Project:

7th and 8th Grade:

- Each 7th and 8th grade student is asked to bring in at least 1 large package or 2 small packages of an item below, based on their Advisory class.
 - ✓ Mrs. Bourdon: Cheddar Goldfish Crackers
 - ✓ Mrs. Meissner: Pretzel Sticks
 - ✓ Mrs. Salisz: Cheerios (regular)
 - ✓ Mrs. Welch: Raisins
 - ❖ These items should be turned into their **Advisory teacher** beginning Monday, January 29th- Friday, February 2nd.
 - ❖ If you are willing and able to bring additional items, please do!

9th – 12th Grade:

- The goal for our 9-12 grade students is to raise a total of \$450. This can be accomplished by each student and teacher just donating \$3.00!
- The grade with the highest percentage of money donated though, will receive a Doughnut Breakfast.
- Money should be turned into each student's **Advisory teacher**, with collection taking place beginning Monday, January 29th – Friday, February 2nd

Sack Decorating:

- Not only do these Sack Suppers provide a well-rounded nutritious meal critical to the development of the brain and body, they also help brighten each child's day!
- Each sack is decorated with positive messages, holiday themes or cheerful illustrations.
 - ✓ All 7th-12th grade students will be asked to decorate **7 sack supper bags** throughout the week of February 28th. (Sack bags will be provided) By doing this, *Kids' Food Basket* will be able to use our bags to give to over 1200 children
 - ✓ In addition, we will have stations set up around the school, so if you happen to stop in for a visit, please decorate a bag to help out kids' in Muskegon County.
