

Sixth Grade Summer Reading Assignment

We feel strongly that all of our students should read as much as possible throughout the entire year, and summer is no exception. This summer, as an incoming sixth grader, you will be required to read and report on a book. This assignment is required from all continuing students, whether you register in April or wait until August. The assignment is due on **Tuesday, September 5, 2017.**

Here are the guidelines for the assignment:

1.) Choose a book from the following list that you have not read:

My Side of the Mountain by Jean Craighead George
Island of the Blue Dolphins by Scott O'Dell

2.) Read the book!

3.) Complete a composition describing a character from the book you chose. This should not be a summary of the book. You might tell about the character's family, physical description, motives for actions, feelings, goals, etc. (Remember to use character traits to describe the character.) Choose at least three categories to use in your composition. Be sure your composition is a minimum of 5 paragraphs including an introduction paragraph, detail paragraphs, and a conclusion paragraph.

4.) Please have your composition typed using double space, 12 font. This final typed composition needs to be turned in to your teacher by Tuesday, September 5th.
